September is Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month



The Whitemarsh Township Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution #2011 - 23 designating September as Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month. Teal Ribbons will be displayed along Germantown Pike for the month of September to recognize and raise awareness of Ovarian Cancer. Each year, more than 22,000 women are diagnosed with the disease in America, and approximately 16,000 die from it, making it the fifth leading cause of cancer death among women.

The [Sandy Rollman Ovarian Cancer Foundation](http://www.sandyrollman.org), a local non-profit advocating for early diagnostic testing and more effective treatments, is organizing the ribbon tying along Germantown Pike. Tying of the ribbons will take place on Wednesday, August 31 at the Township Building at 7 pm.
