This bus tour will follow Whitemarsh Township's history from its founding, through the Revolutionary and Civil Wars, while touching on its industrial and national significance. Participants will be treated to a guided tour by resident historians, listen to historical interpretations and have the opportunity to explore historically significant sites. The tour includes a stop at the Highlands Mansion and Gardens for tea and refreshments. Participants will also receive supplementary materials which will further highlight historical locations on the route.
