

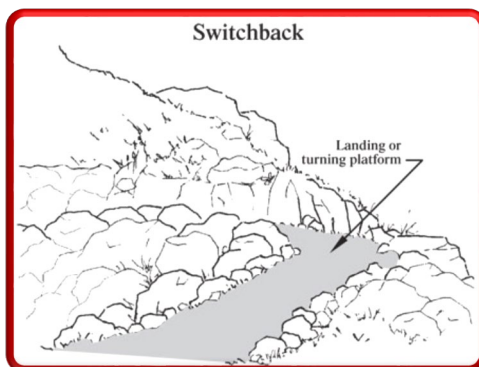
Whitemarsh Township Miracle-Nature Trail (MNT) – Project Summary

- **Feasibility Study Goal:** To determine if a trail and the “Miracle-Nature” concept for the potential trail are feasible and/or desirable to the community.
- **Proposed Location:** 1-mile PECO utility corridor extending through Whitemarsh Township, spanning from the township boundary at Butler Avenue to Hector Street.
- **Key Proposed Trail Connections:** The Schuylkill River Trail, SEPTA Spring Mill Station, the Cross County Trail, and surrounding township and county parks.
- **Miracle-Nature Trail Concept** – to create a linear, ADA accessible, trail that incorporates inclusive sensory elements, natural amenities, and other potential community enhancements.
- **Project Accomplishments to Date:**
 - Fall 2020 - Township received grant funding to conduct a trail feasibility study, interviewed with key project stakeholders & formed a steering committee.
 - January 2021 – First steering committee meeting and review of site analysis plan.
 - February- March 2021 – Public survey was open online for input.
 - April 2021 – Virtual public listening session and presentation was held.
 - May 2020 – Second steering committee meeting and review of draft conceptual sketch & survey/public meeting results.
