

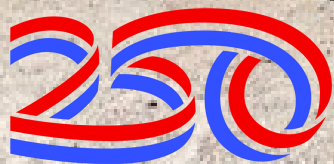

ENROLLMENT MINIMUM CAPACITY

Don't wait! Register early! Every program that Whitemarsh Township Parks & Recreation operates is self sustaining, meaning that we have to meet a certain number of participants to be able to run the program. If we do not meet the minimum required to run the class, Whitemarsh Township Parks and Recreation, as well as our contracted program companies, reserves the right to cancel any program, trip, or camp due to insufficient enrollment.

On the occasion that the department cancels a program, a full refund will be given in the form in which you originally paid. If you paid in cash, a check will be issued to you.

REFUND POLICY PROGRAM, CONTRACTED CAMP

A participant may request to be removed from a program but must do so one week prior to the program start date to receive a full refund, less \$10.00 processing fee, or a full credit to be issued to your communitypass account.

Participant requesting a refund within one week of the program start date will receive a 50% refund or credit. At this point, supplies have already been ordered for programs.

Once a program starts, no refunds will be issued.

We do not pro-rate for late registration.

Refunds / credits are not given for any classes you choose not to attend.

PROGRAMMING

Payments must be received before your registration is considered complete.

Prices, dates, times, locations, and class limits are subject to change. Although we do our best to avoid changes, some may occur due to unavoidable circumstances.

Registrations are accepted online, over the phone, and in person at our Parks & Recreation Administrative Office in Koontz Park, located at 2391 Harts Lane, Lafayette Hill, PA 19444.

We highly recommend that you sign up early, as many programs do fill quickly.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Cancellations and location changes are communicated in a number of ways. Generally updates will be provided via Email or Phone Call, so please ensure your contact information is up-to-date on Community Pass.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Age qualification is determined by the age of the participant as of the first day of the program or class. Certain programs, classes, and events require a parent/guardian to attend and/or participate. If applicable, this requirement will be listed in the program's description.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Medical information is required for all program participants, all information will be kept confidential. This includes, but is not limited to, allergies, learning disabilities, and other professional diagnoses.

PHOTOS

Smile! Photographs will be taken at most programs. Any photos taken could possibly be used in Township publications, websites, or other media. If you prefer not to be photographed, please let us know immediately.

STAFFING

TOWNSHIP STAFFED CAMPS

Whitemarsh Township Parks & Recreation Department operates the Cedar Grove Camp & Miles Park Camp in house. This means that all staff at the Cedar Grove and Miles Park Camp are Township Employees and are directly overseen by our Parks & Recreation Administrative Staff.

Both Cedar Grove Camp and Miles Park Camp have their own set of staff including a Camp Director, Camp Assistant Directors & Camp Counselors.

All Township Staff go through our camp interview process upon being selected for a camp position. All staff also go through all required DHS background checks, drug test and required training. All Staff are also certified in CPR/AED and First Aid Training as well as participating in our camp staff orientation every summer.

Command Staff are also required to attend additional training on camp operations, bullying, mediation and management to just name a few.

Our staff can be easily recognized by our signature Red Staff Shirts that display “Whitemarsh Parks” on the back and “Staff” on the front.

REFUNDS

CEDAR GROVE & MILES PARK CAMPS

In the event that you decide you no longer need a week of camp, you can request a refund in writing to receive a refund based on the below criteria.

Requests can be sent to our general email parkandrec@whitemarshtwp.org or to any of our administrative staff. Please note that we are unable to process withdrawals over the phone or in person.

Due to the popularity of our Township run summer camps a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit will be applied for each week of camp registration per camper. This fee WILL NOT be refunded if a withdrawal occurs.

30 Days Prior to Camp Start

Participant will receive a full refund, minus the \$25.00 nonrefundable deposit per week.

Between 29-14 Days of Camp Start

Participant will receive a 50% refund, minus the \$25.00 nonrefundable deposit.

Within 13 Days of Camp Start

No Refunds will be given.

BEFORE & AFTERCARE

GECKO CLUB

The Before & Aftercare program, also known as Gecko Club, provides extended on-site childcare options for participants enrolled at either Cedar Grove camp or Miles Park Camp. Gecko Club is an extended camp day where staff will provide organized activities as well as free play options for your camper. Gecko Club is offered from 7:00am-8:45am before the start of camp each day, and 4:15pm-6:00 PM after. The full coverage you can sign up for with Whitmarsh Township is 7:00 AM through 6:00 PM if you choose to add before and aftercare daily.

PRE- REGISTRATION

To sign up for Gecko Club you can do so by calling the Parks & Recreation Department at 610-828-7276 or online on your communitypass account. You can also enroll with any of the camp directors on site.

LATE/DAY OF REGISTRATION

We understand that last minute changes & Emergencies come up. If you find that you need Gecko Club the next morning and you didn't have a chance to register, you can do so at the camp when dropping off your camper. If you need to add PM care the same day, you will need to call the Parks & Recreation to add the registration.

PRICING

Pricing for Gecko Club is done daily. Each time you use before and aftercare, it's a separate fee. The daily fee is \$25.00 for a resident and \$30.00 for a non-resident. If you need both am and pm daily, it would be considered two uses, so for a resident it would be \$50.00 a day for both AM and PM care and for a non-resident it would be \$60.00 a day for both AM and PM care.

REFUNDS & TRANSFERS

If you sign up for Gecko Club and find that you do not need it any longer, you can transfer to another day or request a refund as long as it is done prior to the date of the registered Gecko Club. We are unable to transfer or refund once the date you registered for has passed.

AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT

Everyone is given one excused late pickup per summer. Once the second late pick-up occurs, your camper will be auto-enrolled into Gecko Club for a fee of \$40.00. When unexpected campers are enrolled in gecko club additional staff must stay to meet ratio standards to ensure camper safety.

CAMP PAYMENT PLANS

DEFERRED PAYMENT PLANS

We understand that with starting camp registration in December, that it can be a very expensive time of year. Whitemarsh Township provides the option of deferring your camp payments into monthly payments at the time of your registration. Your total balance is divided by the amount of months between your registration date and August 1st. All payments are automatically made on the first of each month. Your first month's balance is due at the time of registration.

Please note that there is a one-time administrative fee of \$25.00 to utilize a deferred payment plan which covers the cost to administer the auto payments each month. This \$25.00 fee is added into your monthly payments. After a deferred payment plan is setup, no additional registrations may be added to the plan. One deferred payment plan is permitted per household.

A credit card must be provided and the card details will be saved on your account until the payment plan ends.

If your credit card expires or is declined on the first of the month, you have 7 business days to provide an alternative card for payment. If your payment does not go through, either because of a declined card or expired card, you will be automatically charged a \$10.00 fee. Payments not received by the 8th day of the month will result in your child's registration being removed from the program. If the decline occurs during camp operational months, your child will not be able to check into camp past the 8-day grace period.

In the event that your payment does not go through either because of a declined card or expired card, you will be charged \$10.00 a month until payments are resumed.

Those individuals entering into the deferred payment plan agreement will solely be responsible for all payments until completion of the payment plan. Otherwise, the participant will be withdrawn from the program.

Whitemarsh Township recognizes that there are some cases in which parental custody may be shared, or one person has been granted sole custody. The parent/guardian registering the child for the program, or entering into a deferred payment plan, is solely responsible for payment of the program. Any payments to be made between parents/guardians are to be handled outside of the Township payment plan process.

To sign up for a deferred payment plan, you must call the Parks & Recreation Department at (610) 828-7276 and register over the phone.

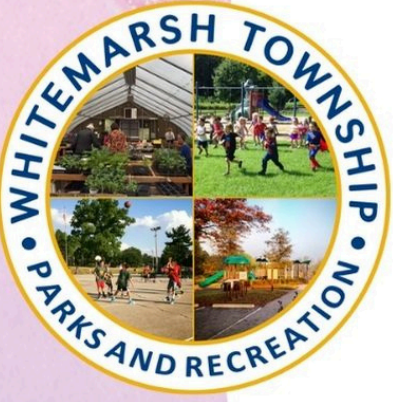

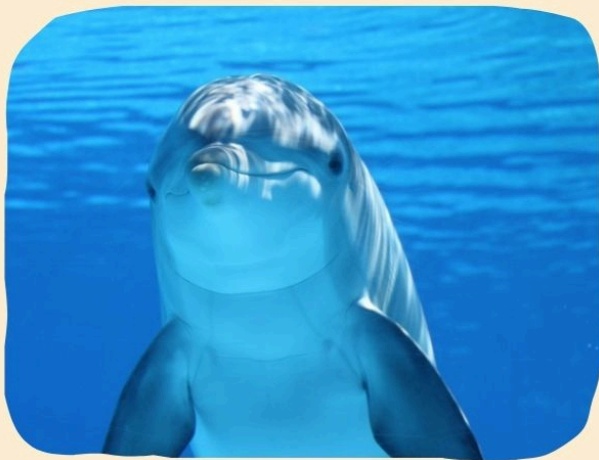

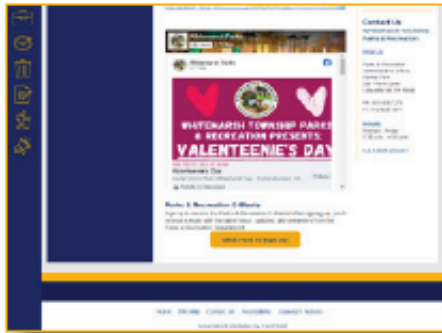
